### Nottingham Business School full-time Master of Business Administration Unemployed Executive's Scholarship Award 2014.

Nottingham Business School will be offering two full-fee scholarships for the full-time MBA starting in April 2014.

These scholarships are available to future students who meet all of the following criteria:

- You must have been offered a place to study on the full-time MBA starting in April 2014.
- You must be an Executive who has more than three years full-time work experience.
- You must have been made unemployed in 2012 or 2013.
- You must not be in employment as of the 20 March 2014.

#### Nature of the Scholarship

These competitive scholarships will be awarded to those candidates who most closely meet the criteria for the award, which are provided above. The scholarship decision will be made by an awarding committee and all decisions of that awarding committee are final. If you are awarded a scholarship your fee will be met in full before enrollment.

#### Application Process

Applications must consist of a fully completed scholarship form which includes a 1500 word competitive essay submission which addresses the question provided below, as well as a 500 word personal statement.

The awarding committee reserve the right to exclude from consideration any applications that include written statements which exceed the stated word limit or are incomplete.

Scholarships received before 4 pm GMT on 20 March will be assessed and successful applicants will be notified of their scholarship award by 28 March 2014.

Please provide on a separate sheet a 1,500 word written essay addressing the following:

“To what extent have you experienced command and control leadership more characteristic of the early 20th century and how did it affect your organisation and you personally. Why was it limiting and what are your experiences or views on an alternative approach?”

Your essay will be assessed against the following criteria:

- Relevance to the question
- Development of an argument
- Structure
- Quality of writing
- Supporting examples
- Conclusions

Please write a personal statement of approximately 500 words to tell us why you should receive this scholarship.

Use the questions below as a guide:

- Tell us about your academic or personal achievements, and any work experience, knowledge and skills that you believe make you a good candidate for the scholarship.
- How will your student experience at Nottingham Business School help you to achieve your career goals?
- What special qualities will you bring to the University?

- Please ensure that you have provided the email address which you used when applying for the MBA.
- Please use separate typewritten sheets for your essay and personal statement.

- Please make sure that you are specific, clear and have carefully proof read your application.

This scheme is applicable to full-time Masters of Business Administration only. The scheme excludes sponsored students (partial / full).

## Nottingham Business School Masters of Business Administration Unemployed Executive's scholarship scheme terms and conditions

1. Applicants are only eligible for consideration of a scholarship award if they have been offered a place on the MBA starting in April 2014. Please Note: NTIC progression students are not eligible to apply for a scholarship. Please check our website for details of funding for NTIC students at [www.ntu.ac.uk/ntic](http://www.ntu.ac.uk/ntic).
2. You will only be considered for a Masters of Business Administration Unemployed Executives scholarship if you meet all of the following criteria:
  - You must have been offered a place to study on the full-time MBA starting in April 2014.
  - You must be an Executive who has more than three year full-time work experience
  - You must have been made unemployed in 2012 or 2013
  - You must not be in employment as of the 20 March 2014.
3. Applicants are only able to apply once for the April 2014 MBA scholarship scheme.
4. The deadline for applications is 4 pm GMT on 20 March 2014. Applications received after this date will not be considered.
5. Scholarships up to the value of the full tuition fee are available although the awarding committee may choose to award a part scholarship.
6. The full fee scholarship will be available in the form of a tuition fee reduction. If you are awarded a scholarship your fee will be met before enrolment.
7. The scholarship is not transferable and will not be awarded if you choose to defer your entry to a different start date or if you choose to transfer to a different course at the University.
8. The scholarship will only be awarded once an applicant accepts and meets the conditions of their offer and are eligible to enrol on the MBA.
9. Scholarships are competitive and selection is based on academic attainment and the outlined selection criteria. It is, therefore, of great importance that you give your essay and personal statement careful thought and preparation and you refer to the criteria provided.
10. The University's decision in all matters relating to the scholarship is final.
11. If your scholarship application is successful, you may be asked to appear in online and / or printed University marketing materials. This may involve providing a student profile and a photograph which may be used to promote the University's scholarship schemes and Masters of Business Administration course.
