- Align the Transport Plan with the Leading in Future Environments (LiFE) Index which NTU annually partakes in to benchmark NTU's performance on environmental and corporate social responsibility issues.

To enable its strategic plans to be met, NTU is committed to:

- Support future development of NTU's estate through the integrated approach to land use and planning via collaborative work with local authorities, the Highways Agency and other stakeholders.
- Improving the townscapes through continued development of aspects of its campuses by improving pedestrian and cycling facilities to promote a safer and more attractive environment.
- Influence the development of Nottinghamshire's transport system through continued work with local authorities to ensure its best interests are met with future transport developments in the region.

To enable the continuation of improved transport solutions for NTU employees and students, NTU is committed to:

- Continue to provide an appropriate Car Parking Strategy.
- Continue to invest in infrastructure that supports staff, student and visitor sustainable modes of transport for example restricted access cycle compounds, shower and locker facilities and bike hire.
