Padlet

There are a range of tools which can be used interactively with students to enable them to share views and opinions and collaborate on projects. One, is **Padlet**. On the **TIPS** Teaching In Practice Series, area of NOW there is a very helpful **Video showing use of Padlet** in a teaching session.

It is free to register and use Padlet and it can be used as an online Poster Board for your Course which all staff and students can access. You can also post pictures, documents and links, so can be an area students use to collaborate on projects. Padlet updates instantly, so you can run as a "back channel" to gather feedback and questions during teaching sessions or the week before a course meeting or event. QR Codes

Free and easy to create and a great way for students to use their mobile devices to link to your interactive activities and content, go to, **https://www.the-qrcode-generator.com/** to learn how to create your own QR codes or scan the QR code to the right to go to the Website!



Use QR codes to provide Text, URLs, Contact details for students; information they can save directly to their mobile phone or device to interact with you, each other and course content.

Download an App for your phone or mobile device to Scan QR codes: For Android-based devices, you can use **Barcode Scanner** by ZXing. On iOS-Devices like iPhones there are also QR Code readers available on the AppStore e.g. **QR Reader for iPhone**. On Firefox OS try **QR Code Scanner**.

Google Forms

Google Forms can be a useful, quick and easy way to survey students both in and outside of lectures. It is free, there is no licence and no limit on the numbers of respondents! Go to **http://www.google.co.uk/forms/about/** to find out more and start creating your own surveys.

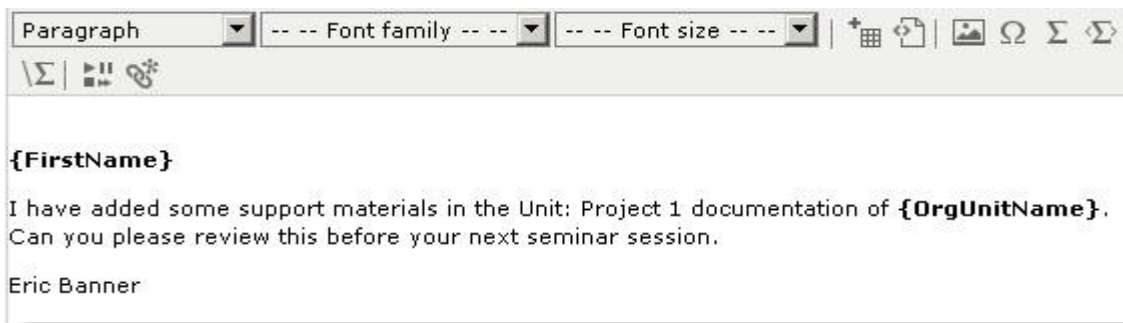

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Personalising your News Items in NOW: Replace strings

You can add simple phrases to personalise News items and NOW emails and identify the learning room by inserting the replace strings directly into the text of the message.

For example, the News text:



... produces the following News item:



Replace strings to insert

Replace strings include single 'curly' brackets before and after and contain no spaces.

Replace String	Description	Appears as
{FirstName}	The first name of the current use i.e. the student	Stephen
{LastName}	The last name of the current user.	Hawking
{OrgUnitName}	The name of the current learning room	LAW_11723: Law of Torts 201213 Full Year
{OrgUnitId}	The system number ID of the learning room	179004
{OrgName}	The name of the current organization.	NTU Online Workspace

Formatting

Replace strings can be treated as text so they can be formatted for Bold, italic and font size.

Remember: replace strings also work in emails issued from NOW e.g. 'message' via the **Classlist** tool.
