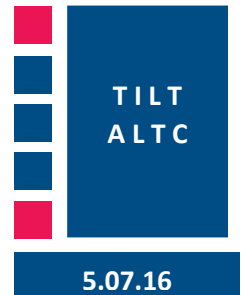


Transforming learning through Scholarship

Learning space at NTU: The way forward

This sessions centred around a discussion and debate on initial proposals for a learning spaces strategy for NTU. Learning spaces are spaces used for teaching (eg classrooms) and student study. There was a brief update on the work to date of the TILT Learning Spaces group and some of the information uncovered about the use of learning spaces here at NTU and elsewhere in the sector. This was an opportunity to influence the forward planning and operation of teaching and study spaces at the University.
