<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is no lectern in this set up. However, one of the tables is designated as the presenter PC and this has the master control to the other PCs and screens in the room.</li> <li>• Splitters (not provided) may be useful for video/audio listening</li> </ul>
