

## Examples of work

In order for us to consider your application, we need you to submit at least 12 examples of your practical work.

**Please upload your examples of work as part of your online application.**

You should include a range of work that supports your application and shows your understanding of your specialist area of study. This is also an opportunity for you to showcase your work.

**Please submit 12 examples of work in the form of images, photographs, drawings or other media, with dates and descriptions of why the projects were undertaken.**

Submit your work as an **Adobe Acrobat PDF**, **Microsoft PowerPoint** or **Apple QuickTime** presentation, which should be:

- no more than 20 slides (this will allow you to include more than one image of each piece of work, if required, plus short descriptions);
- submitted as a single unzipped file not exceeding 10MB (megabytes).

For moving image work, you may submit a web link, pasted into a Word file, to a video hosting site.

Where images are inserted into a presentation they should be:

- in JPEG format;
- a maximum of 72dpi (dots per inch).

The details of your application form and examples of work will be carefully considered when assessing your application. We will use these to look for evidence of your level of subject knowledge, creativity, innovation, intellectual engagement and technical skills.

An electronic copy of all submitted work will be kept by NTU for the duration of the annual application cycle, but will not be held on file for longer than this. Please ensure that all files sent to us are copies.

NTU will not use submitted work for any purpose other than the student application process.
