

PARKING TERMS & CONDITIONS – CLIFTON STAFF & STUDENTS

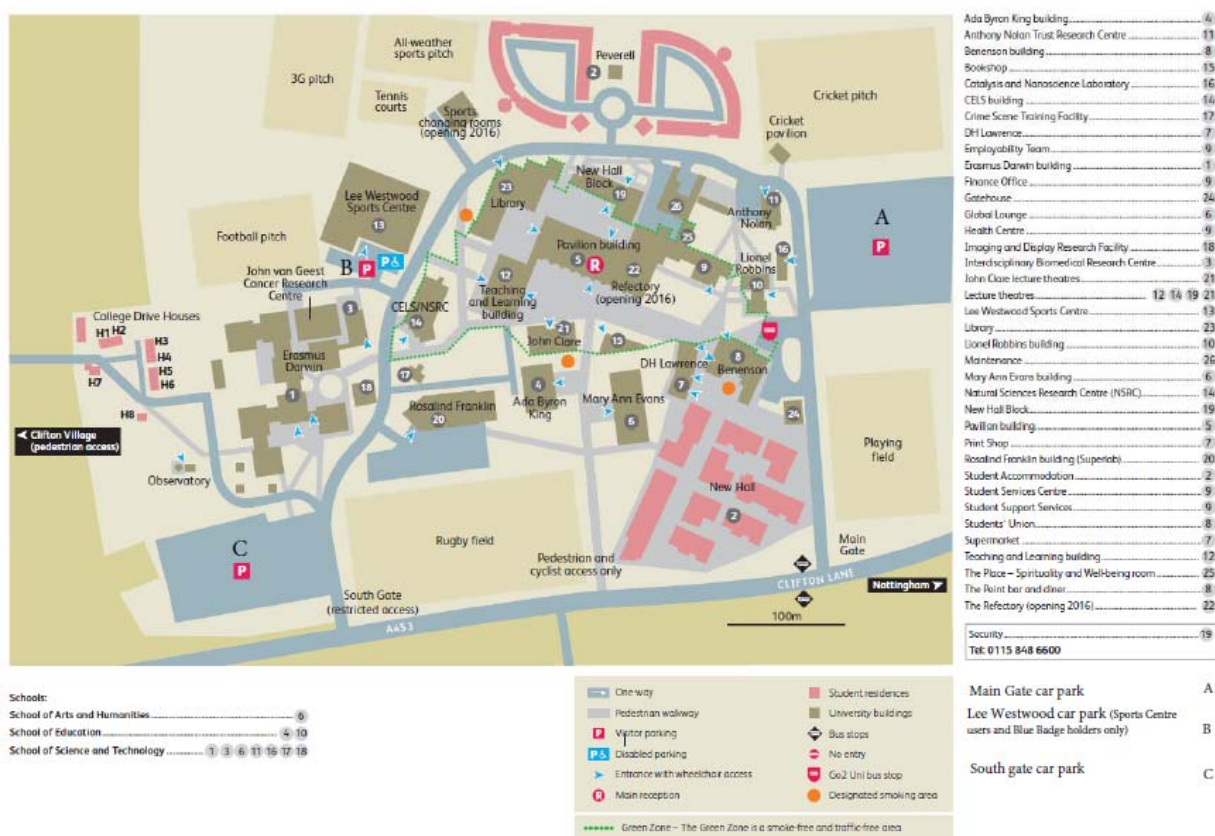
STUDENTS

Students must display a current parking permit whilst parking on NTU land and park in the Main Gate car park only.

STAFF

Staff who pay for their parking by monthly payroll deduction must display a current parking permit whilst parking on NTU land. Staff permit holder parking is available at both Main Gate car park and South Gate car park. Staff paying for their parking via Pay Per Visit do not need to display a parking permit. Staff pay per visit parking is available at South Gate car park. If South Gate is full Pay Per Visit parking may be accommodated at main gate car park if space allows.

N.B Lee Westwood is reserved for Sports Centre parking permit holders and Blue Badge holders only



Terms and conditions

- Unless directed otherwise by a Parking or Security Officer, you must park only in the car parks outlined above and within delineated or otherwise marked parking bays.
- Vehicles must not cause an obstruction, be parked in dangerous places (i.e. on double yellow lines and yellow hatched areas), or in a position to interfere with access of vehicles servicing buildings. Vehicles must not be parked on pavements or on grassed areas. Drivers must not park their vehicle in reserved spaces unless the space is reserved for them.

- Parking in Blue Badge designated spaces is not permitted unless a valid Blue Badge is displayed.
- Staff permit holders and students must display a current permit on the vehicle.
- Parking permits are the property of the University and must be returned if parking approval is withdrawn, you cease studying at the University, or you no longer wish to avail yourself of parking.
- Please email CliftonCityCarParking@ntu.ac.uk of any change of vehicle registration number relating to the permit in order for a new permit to be issued.
- Whilst on NTU land drivers must drive in accordance with the Highway Code and comply with all traffic signs, which include speed restrictions. Drivers are to be especially aware of pedestrians and cyclists on campus.
- Drivers involved in any accident on NTU land resulting in injury to a third party or damage to property must report the facts to the University's Security Services.
- If the vehicle breaks down or there is a legitimate reason why it cannot be removed, Security Services must be informed, and the vehicle moved as soon as possible. Vehicles must not be abandoned – abandoned vehicles will be dealt with in accordance with the Civic Amenities Act 1967 after due notice.
- The University accepts no responsibility for the security of vehicles or their contents.
- Any breach of these parking terms and conditions may result in the withdrawal of the approval to park on University land.
- The University reserves the right to change these parking terms and conditions at any time.

Any breach of these Terms and Conditions or serious conduct issues related to parking may result in disciplinary action.
