EUROPEAN VIDEO CHALLENGE 2020: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

“What does Europe mean to me?”

The European Video Challenge is open to NTU students, from all levels and disciplines, to explore and convey, in the form of a two-minute video, what Europe means to them. Students are free to interpret this question and be as creative as they want.

A selection panel consisting of NTU staff and NTSU members will judge all videos entered by the closing date of 16 March 2020 and select the winning entry. The winning student / student group will have the opportunity to travel to Karlsruhe, Germany, to showcase their video at the Karlsruhe Cultural Festival on the evening of **5th May**. The winning prize will include the cost of flights, accommodation and up to £200 spending money to stay in Karlsruhe in Germany (Nottingham’s twin city) for two nights (5th and 6th May with travel back to the UK on the 7th May). **Please check that the dates of the festival do not clash with exam dates.**

Eligibility criteria: In order to be considered for this challenge a student must be:

- A fully-enrolled student at NTU in the 2019/20 academic year; and
- Must NOT be an incoming / visiting Exchange Student; and
- Must have at least 6 months validity on their passport at the time of departure (May 5th).

The NTU Global Office will consider all applications fairly and consistently. **The decision of the NTU Global Office is final and there is no opportunity to appeal against this decision.**

1. A screenshot of your attendance page on NOW
2. A link to your video

Application deadlines: The application process closes on Monday 16 March 2020 at 23.59. You will receive email notification of the outcome of your application within one-week of the deadline.

About the project: NTU Global are looking for students from any NTU course (including Confetti) to produce a short video responding to the question: *“What does Europe mean to me?”* We want you to think about what Europe means to you and how this might have influenced your own identity. Perhaps you feel part of a big family at NTU and enjoy its values and diversity? Europe could mean the opportunity to travel, meet new people from different cultures and learn new languages. All these ideas and more can be explored within your video.

A panel of 3 judges from NTU and the Creative Quarter will judge the entries and select one lucky winner / group to showcase their video at the Karlsruhe Cultural Festival on **5th May 2020**. The winning prize will include the cost of flights, accommodation and £200 spending money to stay in Karlsruhe in Germany (Nottingham’s twin city) for two nights (5th and 6th May with travel back to the UK on the 7th May). Please check that the dates of the festival do not clash with exam dates. International students who do not have a Schengen Visa will be required to apply for a visa to travel to Germany.

Who can apply? Students can work as an individual or as a group of up to 4 students. This question could be answered by you or other students, NTU colleagues or the community of Nottingham. The video could include footage of students in dialogue, a face to face to camera or a creative/abstract response.

Permissions: Students will be provided with copyright and consent forms. The copyright forms are to evidence permissions obtained for any third-party images/music used and the consent forms are for all film participants to complete. Please ensure that all completed consent forms are placed in a secure location until delivered to the City Global Lounge between Monday 16 and Friday 20 March where we will securely store this data.

Deadline to apply: The deadline to submit your video is **Monday 16 March 2020** via We Transfer (www.wetransfer.com) to: NTUGlobal@ntu.ac.uk Please make sure all video content is submitted in HD or HD264 format and that the duration is between 2 – 3 minutes.
