#### CHINA SUMMER SCHOOLS 2019/20: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Successful students will be attend a Chinese summer school with tuition and accommodation paid. <u>Students are responsible for the costs of flights (approx. £600), visas (approx. £150) and living expenses.</u>

Successful students will be allocated to summer schools after the closing date and will be notified by email within one month. Allocations will be made based on the entry criteria of the Chinese University. Sichuan University summer school (10+ students) usually runs in middle two-weeks of July, Discover SWUFE (2 students) usually runs in the first two-weeks of July.

# PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS AN ACADEMIC PROGRAMME AND YOU ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND CLASSES AND UNDERTAKE ANY ASSIGNMENTS / ASSESSMENTS GIVEN TO YOU BY THE TUTORS.

Eligibility criteria: In order to be considered for this scholarship a student must be:

- A fully-enrolled student at NTU in the 2019/20 academic year; and
- Must be available to attend the whole of the summer school; and
- Must have at least 6 months validity on their passport from time of departure (July 2020): and
- Must NOT be an incoming / visiting Exchange Student; and
- Must NOT be graduating in July 2020.

Priority will be given to students who have had little or no overseas travel experience.

The NTU Global Office will consider all applications fairly and consistently. **The decision of the NTU Global Office** is final and there is no opportunity to appeal against this decision.

- 1. A scan of the photo ID page of your passport
- 2. A screenshot of your attendance page on NOW

**Application deadlines:** The application process opens at 9.00am on Monday 1 October 2019 and closes on Sunday 8 March 2020. You will receive email notification of the outcome of your application within one-month of the deadline.

The University reserves the right to discontinue the China Summer Schools Scheme at any time without prior notice. ## **Award requirements**

- Pre-Departure Meeting you will be required to attend a compulsory pre-departure meeting on the afternoon of Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2020 – location will be confirmed nearer the time.
- 2. You are responsible for applying for your visa at least four-weeks before the summer school start date. Guidance will be provided by NTU Global. Please note that under the new regulations you will need be required to attend a visa centre for biometrics. NTU Global shall be entitled to cancel your place on the scheme if you do not adhere to this deadline.
- 3. You are responsible for booking your return flights to China.
- 4. You are responsible for obtaining the correct vaccinations / medicines from your GP.
- You are <u>required</u> to submit an account of your international experience to the NTU Global Office 1
  month from the return date of travel. Submissions will be used for promotion of the scholarship and
  display by the NTU Global Office.

If, in the reasonable opinion of NTU, you have failed to provide us with all relevant information or have supplied false or misleading information relating to your application, we shall be entitled to cancel your place on the scheme.
