Tawakkol Karman turns 40 on 7th February and is a Yemeni journalist, politician and human rights activist leading the group "Women Journalists Without Chains" which she co-founded in 2005. She became the first Arab woman and the second Muslim woman to win a Nobel Prize as well as the second youngest Nobel Peace Laureate to date.

Stonewall Riots



28th June is the 50th anniversary of the Stonewall riots, a series of spontaneous, violent demonstrations by members of the LGBT community against a police raid that occurred early morning at the Stonewall Inn, a gay club, located in Greenwich Village in New York. They served as a catalyst for the gay rights movement and the modern fight for LGBT rights.

This was the Rosa Parks moment, the time that gay people stood up and said no.

4th July marks 85 years since the death of Marie Curie, a Polish and naturalized-French physicist and chemist who conducted pioneering research on radioactivity. She was the first woman to win a Nobel Prize, the first person and only woman to win twice and the only person to win a Nobel Prize in 2 different sciences.

I have frequently been questioned, especially by women, of how I could reconcile family life with a scientific career. Well, it has not been easy.




