Nottingham Post Executive Master of Business Administration Scholarship

Nottingham Business School will be offering a half fee scholarship which will be available to a student starting the Executive MBA (EMBA) in January 2018.

Nature of the scholarship

This competitive scholarship will be awarded to a candidate who most closely meets the criteria for the award, through their personal statement and discussion question answer. The scholarship decision will be made by an awarding committee and all decisions made by that awarding committee are final. The scholarship will be available in the form of a tuition fee reduction and if you are awarded the scholarship your fee will be adjusted before enrolment.

The scholarship will only be awarded if you meet the entry criteria for the EMBA course. For further information on the course entry criteria please visit www.ntu.ac.uk/EMBA

Sponsored students (full / part) are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Application process

Applications must consist of a fully completed scholarship application form which includes a 1,000 word competitive essay submission addressing the question provided below.

The awarding committee reserve the right to exclude from consideration any applicants whose written statements exceeds the stated word limit or is incomplete.

Nottingham Post Executive Master of Business Administration Scholarship terms and conditions

1. Applicants are only able to apply once for the January 2018 Nottingham Post Executive Master of Business Administration scholarship scheme.
2. The deadline to submit a scholarship application is 4 pm GMT on 4 December 2017. Applications received after this deadline date will not be considered.
3. The scholarship is available to eligible UK, EU and international students who meet the entry criteria for the Executive MBA.
4. A scholarship up to the value of half the tuition fee is available although final amount of award will be at the discretion of the awarding committee.
5. If you are awarded any other scholarship, bursary or fee reduction from the University, the total amount awarded by the awarding committee will not exceed more than half the tuition fee.
6. The scholarship will be available in the form of a tuition fee reduction. If you are awarded the scholarship your tuition fee will be adjusted before enrolment.
7. The scholarship is not transferable and will not be awarded if you choose to defer your entry to a different start date or if you choose to transfer to a different course at the University.
8. The scholarship will only be awarded if the applicant meets the entry criteria for the EMBA, is made an offer by the University, accepts and meets the conditions of their offer and is eligible to enrol on the EMBA.
9. If you are awarded a scholarship you will need to apply for a place on the EMBA course within two weeks of the scholarship confirmation communication. If you do not apply for a place on the EMBA within this time frame the scholarship offer will be withdrawn.
10. Scholarships are competitive and selection is based on the personal statement and discussion question answer. It is, therefore, of great importance that you give these items careful thought and preparation and you refer to the criteria provided.
11. The University's decision in all matters relating to the scholarship is final.
12. If your scholarship application is successful, you may be asked to appear in online and / or printed University marketing materials. This may involve providing a student profile and a photograph which may be used to promote the scholarship scheme, or writing a blog.
