Who are the CIPD?

The Chartered Institute of Personnel and Development (CIPD) is the professional body for Human Resources and people development. There are over 130,000 members internationally - working in Human Resources, learning and development, people management and consulting across private businesses and organisations in the public and voluntary sectors. The CIPD is recognised throughout the world and having a qualification approved by the CIPD can help you to secure a job in Human Resources and improve your chances of progression in your career.

CIPD Membership with your MSc

There are three levels of professional membership with the CIPD - Associate Member, Chartered Member and Chartered Fellow. Providing you become a student member of the CIPD when studying, successful completion of the MSc in Human Resource Management will provide you with Associate Membership. Your MSc will be recorded by the CIPD as meeting the knowledge requirements to progress to Chartered Member status. This progression or upgrading will be possible when you are employed in a HR position and when you can demonstrate practical HR experiences and behaviours at the appropriate level. At this point you will need the support of your employer who will be able to confirm your competency. For those students who enter the programme with HR experience it may be possible to immediately upgrade to Chartered Membership upon successful completion of the programme.
