Nottingham Trent University (NTU) is committed to water management measures which, in addition to meeting all legal requirements and approved codes of practice, aim to minimise water wastage and optimise the use of water saving and harvesting technologies.


Policy Aims

This policy is to clarify the water management that takes place at the University and to reflect the commitments set out in the University's Environmental Policy.

Policy Objectives

NTU is committed to:

- Comply with all relevant legal and legislative requirements relating to water use, consumption and efficiency
- Identify areas of significant water use at the University in order to set appropriate objectives and action plans designed to reduce water waste
- Reducing year on year water consumption, per FTE staff & student
- Monitor and report on water consumption
- Procuring water in line with the NTU's Procurement Policy
- Support the purchase of water efficient products and services as outlined in the NTU Sustainable Purchasing Policy
- Develop a programme of preventative maintenance to maintain and optimise the water efficiency of installed building services
- Consider the use of water harvesting technologies
- Ensure the availability of information and necessary resources to achieve water objectives and targets
- Consider and implement, where possible, water saving and harvesting technologies within all new build and major refurbishment projects in line with the NTU Carbon Reduction Strategy for the Estate
- Provide compliant vehicle wash down facilities for the NTU fleet
- Drinking water facilities will be provided for staff and students across the estate
