

NTU is one of the largest universities in the UK with over 29,371 students and 3,260 employees. It is a leader in delivering education and research that shapes lives and society for all staff and students. The University occupies over 100 buildings located over four campuses: City site, Clifton Campus, Brackenhurst Campus and Confetti Campus.

The scope of Nottingham Trent University's environmental management system has been determined to apply to all the buildings and land shown in the site plans for City, Clifton and Brackenhurst campuses. The scope includes all operations including the management of the estate and regeneration activities within all the schools and activities of professional services.

The EMS scope does not include externally managed halls of residence or content of the curriculum, although NTU is fully committed to integrating sustainability into all courses through its Green Academy work.

The EMS does not include Confetti, (the trading name of Nova Centric Limited and Confetti Constellations Limited), a separate legal entity acquired by NTU in 2016. The University Executive Team has decided that it will not be included within the scope but that support will be given to Confetti for the development and implementation of its standalone ISO 14001 certification.
