

Sustainable Construction Policy

In line with the Carbon Reduction Policy, Nottingham Trent University is committed to building and refurbishing our Estate in a manner that reduces carbon emissions.

The following guidelines will be adhered to during the development of new buildings and major refurbishments of existing buildings:

New Buildings – any new construction project or campus development

Mandatory requirements:

- BREEAM Excellent or better.
- Energy Performance Certificate of A or better.

Aspirational targets:

- Display Energy Certificate of A or better within 3 years of completion.
- Consider Passivhaus and other innovative Sustainability marks.

Major Refurbishments – classified by the Chief Operating Officer & Registrar

- Major building refurbishments to achieve BREEAM Very Good or better.
- At least one full grade improvement to Display Energy Certificate.
- Incorporate zonal power controls where possible.

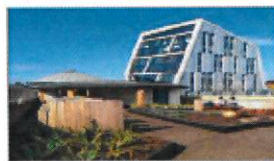
For new builds, refurbishments and the existing estate, Building Opening Times will match demand and will make provision for reasonable out of hours access where demonstrably required.
